Components of the On-Line Foreign Language Instruction in German Program

'Umriß von D2 Themen'

This document list information for all 10 Aufgaben in the German 2 program. For each individual Aufgabe or lesson the 'topic of the lesson' is stated, the computer programs to be completed in the lesson are listed, and it is correlated with the chapter and needed vocabulary lessons in the Deutsch Konkret 2 textbook.

'Plan für das 1. (erste) Sem.' (Semester) [and later 'das 2. (zweite) Semester']

This document provides an overview of the scheduling of the units throughout the semester. It indicates when the units should be completed, what items will tested orally, what stories are supposed to be read, what programs and lessons are available to be heard, the number of required computer programs per Aufgabe, and what reading and speaking tests are required.

'Pretest zu Beginn vom Jahr'

Two versions of the pretest are located here. Each student should start German 2 by completing the pretest without using ANY assistance or reference material. In this way the instructor can determine where the student has weaknesses in the previous year's material and provide the student with a personalized list of computer programs from the previous year's work for review and relearning. The pretest is, obviously, only valuable for this purpose if the student does not look up any answers to the items requested. It is not a graded part of the German 2 curriculum, but is designed to help the student be better prepared to complete the German 2 material with a high level of success.

'Organisierungskonzepte für D2'

These are some procedural pages that indicate how to work through each Aufgabe, what one can do for some extra credit, a few hints for successful learning and how to organize a unit package.

'Lesen- und Lernstrategien'

In these two papers one can read suggestions from persons skilled in learning theories for ways to improve ones learning through reading and ways to study and learn more effectively. These are worth reading.

'Information über Höraktivitäten'

These pages list the listening items from *Learn to Speak German* that have been assigned in German 1 and German 2 through the first semester.

There are also the titles of all 52 dialogs in the Deutsche Welle Beginning language series with their associated grammar themes listed.

A couple of other listening and learning alternatives are provided as well.

'Grammatische Erklärungen'

This lists the grammatical explanation pages by the Aufgabe in which they first are presented and also in an alphabetical table for all of German 2.
